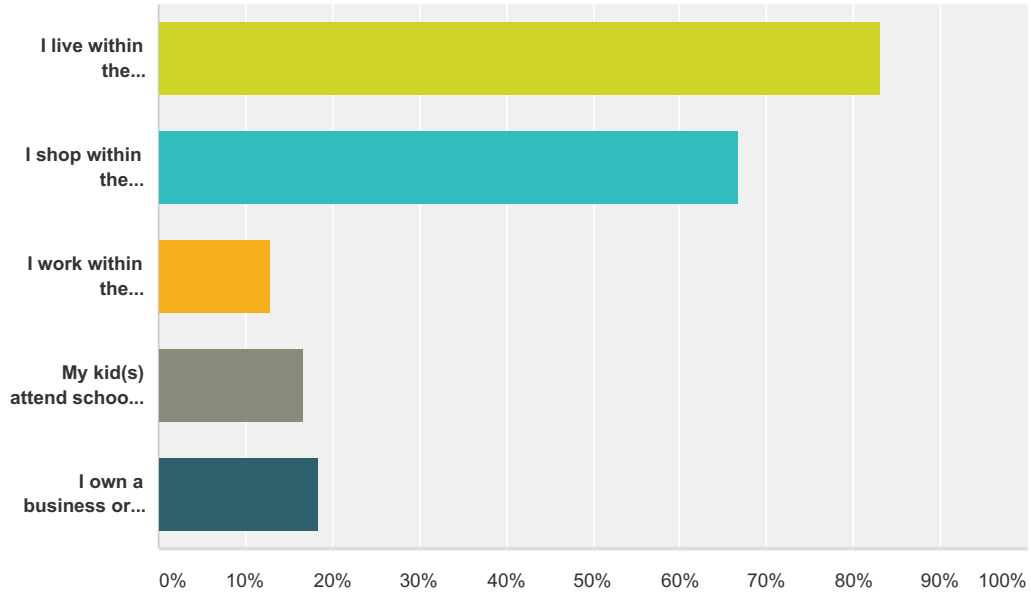


Q1 What's your relationship to the Woodstock neighborhood? (Check all that apply.)

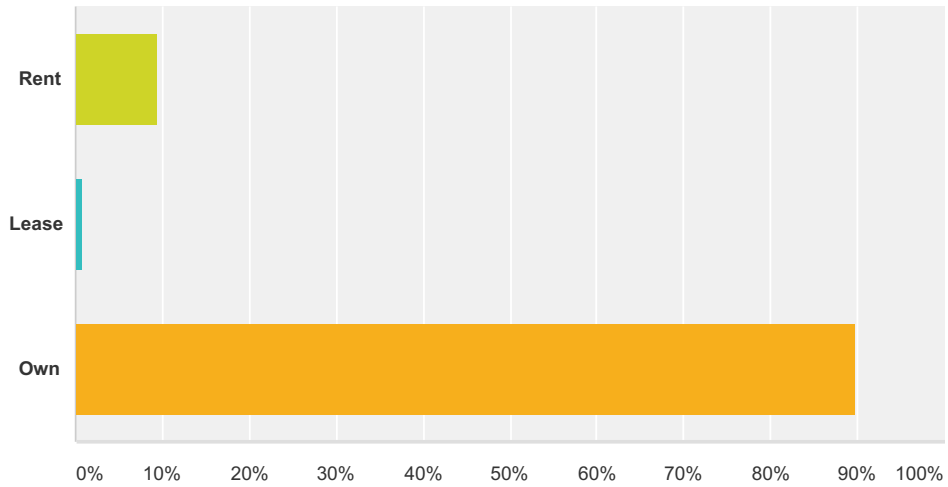

Q2 If you live within or own a business within the Woodstock neighborhood boundary, do you rent, lease, or own the building?

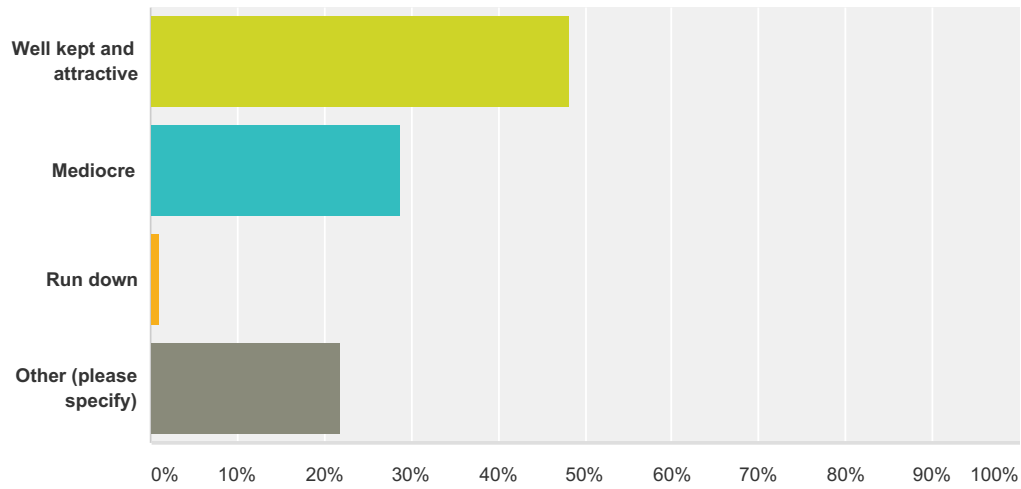

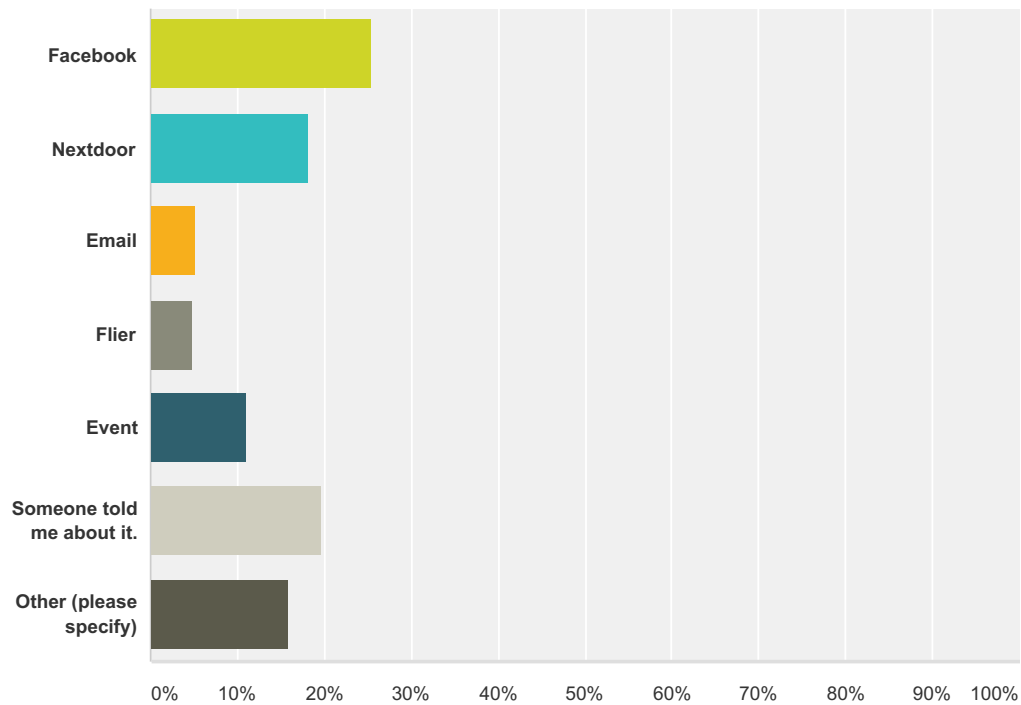

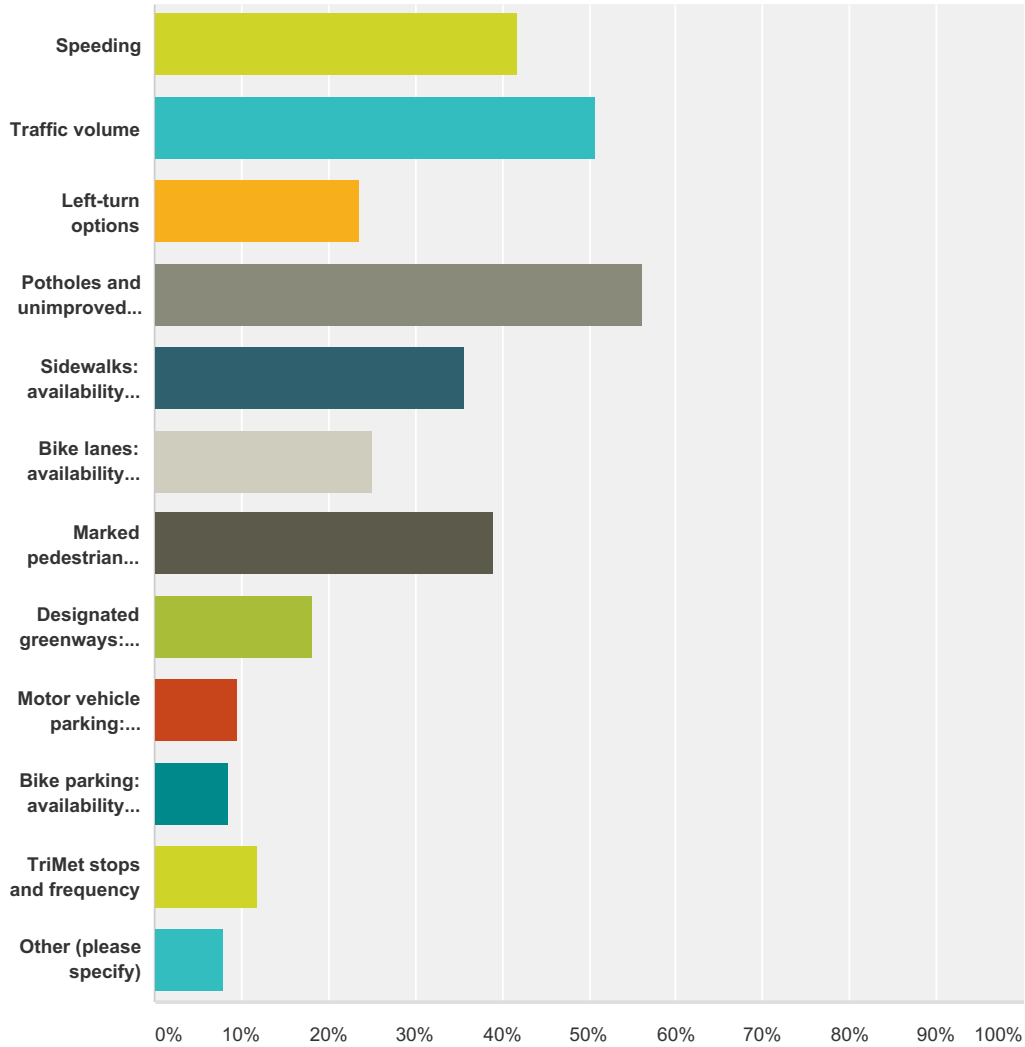

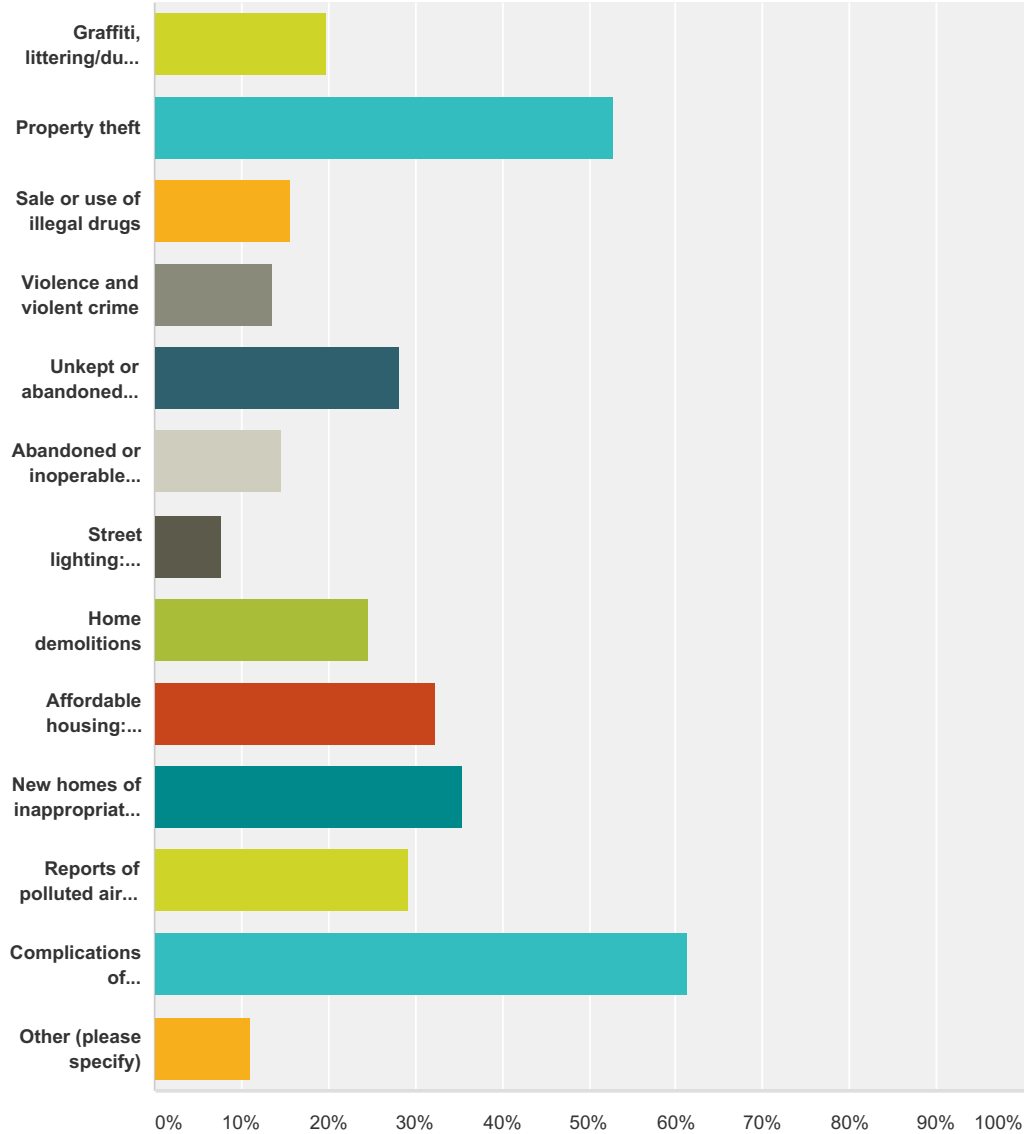
